Aim of the Job

- To teach Welsh to various ages and levels in the communities
- To collaborate with tutors and local teachers to create good practice
- To work together with the communities to restore the good habits of carrying out social activities in the Welsh language

Job Context

The Welsh Language Scheme in Chubut offers a unique opportunity for qualified individuals to learn and develop the Welsh language in Chubut Province, Patagonia. Contracts are offered from February 2026 until December 2026.

The closing date for applications is the 8th September and interviews will be held before the end of October. Jobs will be offered according to agreement when funding from the Welsh Government is confirmed for the Learning Welsh Scheme in 2026.

Accommodation for the period of the agreement will be provided free of charge to the successful applicants by the local communities in Patagonia.

Those appointed should be well versed in the field of teaching Welsh to adults or in the field of nursery/primary education. These will be development jobs. We are looking for individuals who will be ready to collaborate and advise the local tutors and the local committees of the Welsh classes and organize and coordinate language socialization activities.

One positions will be offered in the Camwy Valley (Trelew and Gaiman Area) and one position will be offered in the Andes (Esquel and Trevelin Area) teaching either children, adults or both. This will be reviewed based on the recommendations of the Annual Report of the Welsh Language Scheme. Also during the pandemic there was great interest from outside the province to learn Welsh so the ability to learn online is an advantage.

Main Tasks and Responsibilities

1	Collaborate with teachers and tutors in order to provide dynamic teaching and assist in preparing materials for class use according to local needs .
2	Sharing contemporary practice in the world of education from Wales with teachers in the Y Wladfa in order to strengthen the provision of learning Welsh as a second language.
3	Contribute to the development of the Welsh curriculum in the schools while considering their unique needs.
4	Collaborate with tutors/teachers in order to develop their professional skills and improve their language skills.
5	Be available for teachers/tutors to ask about issues related to learning Welsh Second Language.
6	Create links between schools/agencies in Wales and Argentina.
7	Promote the use of the Welsh language in the local communities by organizing social activities and by attending cultural events and festivals (eg ceremonies, eisteddfodau). eisteddfodau)
8	Promote the work of the Plan in the schools and classes by using social media.
9	Be visible within the Welsh communities as a representative of Wales.
10	Any further duties within reasonable boundaries which are part of the Welsh language provision in the Y Wladfa.
